



## ST. PATRICK'S PRIMARY SCHOOL

# ENROLMENT POLICY

1. Siblings of children already enrolled in the school
2. Priority for enrolment is given to students who are Baptised Catholics.
3. Enrolments are also invited for children from Catholic families (the parent/siblings – Catholic).
4. The student is a resident of the Parish School catchment.
5. The parents/guardian, as the prime educators of their children in faith, must demonstrate a commitment to upholding the teachings of the Catholic Church in practical ways and agree to support the school in all aspects of the total education of their child.
6. The availability of places in the particular Year level during a school year.
7. Enrolments are also accepted from non-Catholic+ students who are transferring from another Catholic school.

In practice, the enrolment policy means that the School enrolls children who

- a. are Baptised Catholics;
- b. if not Baptised Catholics, have at least one parent who is a Baptised Catholic; or
- c. if not Baptised Catholics and without a parent who is a Baptised Catholic, are transferring directly from another Catholic school.
